
TRIAGE & REGISTRATION




Patients are seen in the order of priorities listed below, instead of by arrival time. There may be delays for Priority 2 or 3 pets. Thank you for your patience.



PRIORITY 1

STAT/Emergent - May require life-saving measures

- Hit by car
- Heatstroke
- Cardiac arrest
- Active seizure
- Severe trauma
- Poison ingestion
- Coma/collapse
- Trouble breathing
- Pale/white/blue gums
- Uncontrolled bleeding
- Unable to urinate
- Distended abdomen



PRIORITY 2

Urgent - Requires emergent care

- High fever
- Severe pain
- Snake bite
- Head injuries
- Broken bones
- Allergic reaction
- Severe eye injury
- Bloody diarrhea
- Difficulty giving birth
- Serious chronic illness
- Trouble walking/paralysis
- Frequent vomiting/diarrhea



PRIORITY 3

Stable - Needs care, unlikely life-threatening

- Limping
- Bruising
- Constipation
- Minor wounds
- Skin conditions
- Infection/swelling
- Lethargy
- Not eating/drinking
- Coughing/congestion
- Ear infection
- Anal gland problems
- Occasional vomiting/diarrhea
